



Facility Rules & Regulations

The Salina Tennis Alliance strictly enforces the following rules and regulations to all players, visitors, spectators, and coaches. Failure to abide by these rules and regulations may result in a ban from the tennis center.

Players assume all risks associated with play.

Attire:

- Shirts must be worn at all times.
- Clothing must be appropriate tennis attire.
- Everyone must wear appropriate tennis shoes with non-marking rubber soles to enter the courts. Flip-flops, sandals, boots, bare feet, high heels, or other inappropriate footwear is not allowed.

Conduct:

- Players may be held liable for any damages caused due to negligence of the player.
- Smoking (including smokeless/e-cigarettes or vapes) is not allowed anywhere on the premises.
- Loud, offensive, or foul language is not allowed at any time.
- No hanging signs, moving fixtures, or otherwise changing the appearance of the tennis center.
- Teaching private lessons/teaching for pay/hitting for pay is **strictly prohibited** without direct permission from the Salina Tennis Alliance director.
- Hosting tournaments or other events at the facility is strictly prohibited without direct permission from the Salina Tennis Alliance director.
- All players and visitors must abide by the “Inclement Weather Policy” and are prohibited from playing on wet, puddled, or slick courts.
- Tennis is the only activity allowed on the courts— bicycles, skateboards, skates, etc. are prohibited.
- Sitting, pushing, pulling, or climbing on nets and fences is not allowed.
- No animals are allowed on the courts or in the facility off-leash.
- STA assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen items.

Court Usage & Payments for Courts, Lessons, Clinics, and other Programming:

- Six of the courts can be reserved online up to 7 days in advance at the rate of \$5 per hour/person. If these courts are not reserved then they are open for free play.
- The other six courts are free and are available on a first come, first serve basis and are unable to be reserved in advance. If people are waiting, play on these courts is limited to 1.5 hours. These courts may be unavailable during events and other activities.
- Reserved courts that are not claimed 15 minutes after the designated starting time may be assigned to others waiting to play.
- Courts may be unavailable to the general public during large tournaments or other events.
- Payment for courts, lessons, clinics, and other programming must be made in advance of participation. Payment for services will be accepted via cash or credit card. Checks are not accepted.

Inclement Weather Policy

- Courts and surrounding areas will be cleared of spectators, visitors, and players if there is lightning in a 6-mile radius of the facility.
- When thunder and/or lightning is first heard, spotted, or identified, all participants, guest, and visitors will be directed to take shelter either inside their vehicles or inside the facility.
- Standing on porches, patios, or under any other outdoor tent or covering is prohibited.
- Play shall only resume when lightning has cleared the area or if 30 minutes have passed since the last registered lightning strike.
- Play is not allowed on puddled, wet, or damp courts under any circumstances.
